

AML/CTF By-Law

1. Purpose and application

(a) The purpose of this By-Law is to support the Club's compliance with the Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorism Financing Act 2006 (Cth), the AML/CTF Rules, the Club's AML/CTF Program as adopted and amended from time to time, and any other applicable AML/CTF laws or regulatory requirements.

(b) This By-Law applies to members and other persons in connection with gaming machine services, gaming machine areas and access to or use of Club premises, amenities, facilities and services.

2. Delegated authority

(a) The Secretary or their authorised delegate may exercise the powers in this By-Law where the Secretary or authorised delegate considers it necessary or desirable to administer the Club's AML/CTF Program and AML/CTF compliance framework.

3. Authorised actions

(a) The Secretary or their authorised delegate may request information or documents, refuse or cease providing gaming machine services, suspend or withdraw a right to play gaming machines, refuse or withdraw permission to enter gaming machine areas, or impose conditions on access to or use of, Club premises, amenities, facilities or services.

(b) The Secretary or their authorised delegate may remove, exclude or refuse entry to a member or other person from Club premises to:

(i) comply with the requirements of the Club's AML/CTF Program as adopted and amended from time to time, the AML/CTF Act, the AML/CTF Rules and any other applicable AML/CTF laws or regulatory requirements; or

(ii) enforce decisions made by the Secretary pursuant to, or incidental to, the operation and administration of the Club's AML/CTF Program and AML/CTF compliance framework.

4. Duration, review and variation

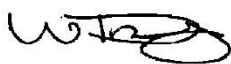
(a) Any action taken under this By-Law may remain in effect for so long as the Secretary or their authorised delegate considers necessary or desirable for the purposes of this By-Law.

(b) The Secretary or their authorised delegate may review, vary or withdraw any action taken under this By-Law as circumstances require.

5. Non-disciplinary character

(a) Unless the Club proceeds under the disciplinary provisions of the Constitution, action under this By-Law is an administrative AML/CTF compliance and risk-management measure and does not suspend or expel a member from membership.
